# approximately adverb

used for showing that an amount or number is not exact:

Approximately 60,000 people filled the stadium.

area noun [count]

a part of a place or building: My family has lived in this area of England for years.

astronaut noun [count] someone who travels in space

## average adjective

calculated by adding several numbers together and dividing the total by the number of things that you added together:

winds with an average speed of 15 miles per hour

## baseball noun [uncount]

a game played by two teams of nine players who score points by hitting a ball with a bat and then running around four bases

#### cover verb

to be all over a surface or object: *His clothes were covered in mud.* 

#### dessert noun [count or uncount]

sweet food that you eat after the main part of a meal

## flag noun [count]

a piece of cloth with colours or a pattern on it, used as a signal or for representing a country or organization

**independent** adjective not controlled by another country or organization: *an independent nation* 

**life expectancy** noun [count or uncount] the length of time that someone is likely to live

**mammal** noun [count] an animal that is born from its mother's body, not from an egg, and drinks its mother's milk as a baby

#### moon noun

the Moon or the moon the object similar to a planet that goes round the Earth and that you can see shining in the sky at night: *The moon was shining brightly.*  **pie** noun [count or uncount] a food that consists of meat, vegetables, or fruit cooked inside a case of pastry *a piece/share/slice of the pie* 

**pop** adjective relating to popular music: *a pop singer/record/song* 

## population noun [singular]

the number of people who live in a particular area: *Los Angeles has a population of over 3 million.* 

set foot phrase
to go to a place:
It was the first time I had set foot on French soil.

### species noun [count]

a plant or animal group whose members all have similar general features and are able to produce young plants or animals together: *Over 120 species of birds have been recorded in this National Park.* 

#### spell verb

to write or say the letters of a word in the correct order: *Can you spell 'beautiful'?* 

## symbol noun [count]

someone or something that represents a particular idea or quality: Many Catholics saw him as a symbol of hope.
